On January 8th, we participated in a special ceremony at the historic neighborhood of Prospect Heights in East Austin! We were honored to be in the company of HUD Acting Secretary Adrienne Todman, Austin Mayor Kirk Watson, Housing Authority of the City of Austin (HACA) CEO Michael Gerber, and Travis County Judge Andy Brown, as we raised the first wall on 12 of our new affordable townhomes.

During the ceremony, we paid tribute to President Jimmy Carter by signing a memorial wall in his honor, celebrating his legacy and commitment to affordable housing. We were also proud to receive a proclamation from Travis County recognizing the impact of this work and the importance of making homeownership more accessible. Working alongside HACA and other partners, we're building a coalition that is united in tackling the affordability crisis of Austin's tough housing market.

As our CEO, Michele Anderson, took the podium, she shared a powerful quote from President Carter: **"My faith demands that I do whatever I can, wherever I can, whenever I can, for as long as I can."** His words remain a guiding inspiration in our mission to empower and uplift the communities we serve.
