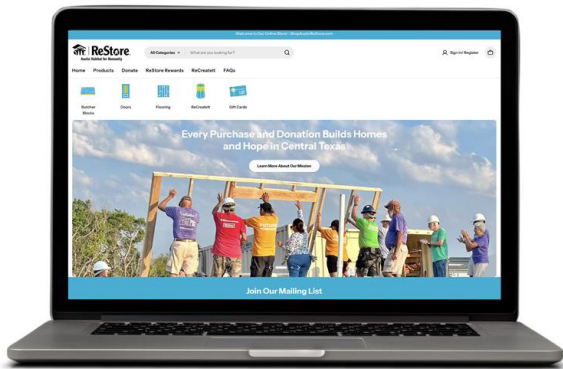


ReStore Updates
