In February, we celebrated an important milestone in East Austin as **12 families were welcomed to their future homes at Prospect Heights**. As parents and children experienced their dream becoming real, the moment underscored what stable housing can provide: pride, security, and a foundation for the future. It was a powerful reminder of the collective impact of our community.

Prospect Heights is built on the historic site of Rosewood Courts, a place deeply rooted in East Austin's history and culture that has supported families for generations. **Through our partnership with the Housing Authority of the City of Austin**, this legacy continues by expanding access to affordable homeownership while honoring the significance of this community.

We are deeply grateful to the supporters, volunteers, partners, and advocates who made this milestone possible. Your commitment and generosity transformed a historic site into a place where families can build stability, put down roots, and create new memories for years to come.



A Place to Call Home

Meet Magenta, **one of the new homeowners at Prospect Heights**. A single mother of three and a 32-year Austin resident, Magenta works as a Public Liaison for the Public Utility Commission of Texas, where she helps residents navigate essential services. Like many families, rising rents repeatedly pushed her farther from the community she loves, making long-term stability feel out of reach.

Through the partnership between Austin Habitat for Humanity and the Housing Authority of the City of Austin, that dream is finally becoming reality. "Homeownership seemed like a faraway dream for me," Magenta says. **"But with Austin Habitat, I know I can afford to become a homeowner and give my daughters a place they can always come home to."**

Affordable Homes Available Now

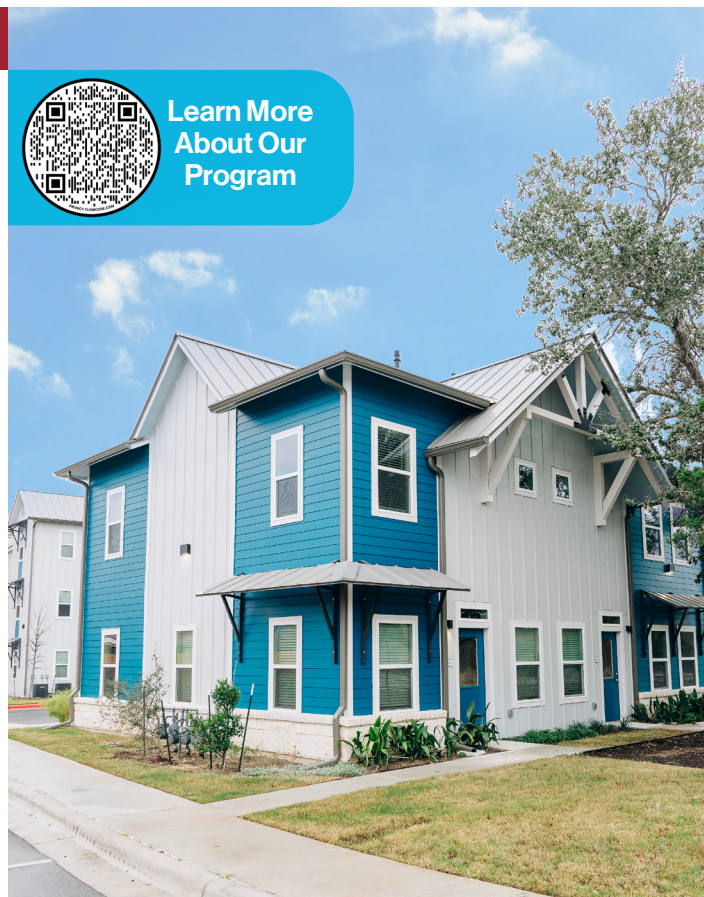
